On August12, 2018, TX-TF1 deployed three water squads at the request of the Texas Division of Emergency Management in response to heavy rains and flash flooding in Uvalde, Texas.

The Uvalde Sheriff's office reported that the area received up to 11 inches overnight and the Nueces River had risen two feet above flood stage. TX-TF1 personnel were directed to chalk bluff and conducted a wide area search along the Nueces River, marking two vehicles, verifying that there were no trapped victims inside.

On August 13, Task Force personnel coordinaed with the local jurisdiction by assisting with welfare checks and searching along rivers before demobilizing to their home stations after flood waters receded.
