## Type – RAIN

With the threat of more flooding across Texas, on May 1, 2019, TDEM activated four TX-TF1 Water Rescue Squads, one Water Group Supervisor, and one Support Specialist. The squads staged in Hills, McLennan, Navarro, and Dallas counties to assist locals. Additionally, one Texas State Guard Water Squad was also activated with one of he TX-TF1 Water Rescue Squads in Dallas County.

On May 2, TX-TF1 Water Rescue Squads assisted the Waco Fire Department by responding to multiple people trapped in water. They continued to engage in multiple high-water rescue calls through May 3.

On May 4, 2019, all resources were demobilized due to the storms exiting the state. The teams completed multiple wellness checks and served as backup for local responders.
