Tropical Storm Barry made landfall in Central Louisiana as a strong tropical storm a little before 2pm on Saturday July 13. Several rivers in both Louisiana and Texas were already in flood stage and were forecasted to rise with the addition of rain from Barry.

In response to events such as flash floods and major rain, Texas A&M Task Force 1 had members deployed Friday, July 12. They deployed 2 Water Rescue Squads, 1 Water Group Supervisor, and a Support Specialist to stage in Beaumont to prepare. All resources were demobilized on July 15, once the storm turned east away from Texas.

Later in the afternoon on July 15, two Water Rescue Squads and one Water Group Supervisor were re-activated and staged in College Station to be ready in the event of possible flooding.

On Tuesday, July 16th, the Task Force members began demobilization.
