## Type – RAIN

On January 10, 2020, Texas A&M Task Force 1 was activated by Texas Division of Emergency Management as a Type 3 Search and Rescue Team and one Emergency Support Function Nine Liaison to prepare for possible tornadoes and high winds across the state of Texas. They stayed ready for deployment in College Station . The storm caused flash flooding in Cooke County with four inches per hour rainfall. Due to the flooding, TDEM activated two Water Rescue Squads, one Water Croup Supervisor, and a driver to assist locals in Grayson County with swiftwater rescues. When the teams arrived, assistance was no longer needed.

On January 11, 2020, after no requests for service, all resources were demobilized back to their home stations.
