On July 7, 2021, the Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 to assist with flash flooding in regions 2, 3, and 6. The team included 7 Swiftwater Rescue Squads, 1 Floodwater Rescue Squad, 2 Water Group Supervisors, and Support Specialists. The squads staged in Wharton, Rockport, Three Rivers, Corpus Christi, and Kingsville.

On July 8, 2021, the squads followed the threat of flooding to region 3 and 6 to assist the locals with minor emergencies and accidents. They assisted local police in recovering human remains from a residence trapped by flood water and performed an evacuation. Over the next day they continued to recon low water crossings.

On July 10, 2021, with no further request for service, TDEM demobilized 4 of the Water Rescue Squads. The remaining squads continued to monitor flood prone areas across regions 2, 3, and 6. The next day on July 11, 2021, all remaining resources were demobilized and returned to their home stations.
