
Deployment Statistics

Lasted a total of 4 days

46 Personnel activated supporting the following resources:

- 1 Type 3 Search & Rescue Team
- 2 Swiftwater Rescue Squads



Type – RAIN

On April 26, 2023, TX-TF1 was activated by the Texas Division of Emergency Management due to flash flooding predicted in regions 1, 2, and 6. They deployed 2 Swiftwater Rescue Squads along with 1 Water Group Supervisor, and staged overnight in Palestine and Red Springs. TDEM also activated TX-TF2 due to high winds and threat of tornadoes. They activated as a Type 3 Search & Rescue Team to stage overnight in Dallas awaiting orders.

Throughout the day on April 27, 2023, TX-TF2 remained staged in Dallas. The TX-TF1 Swiftwater Squads relocated to College Station to await requests. On April 28, 2023, there was one request for the TX-TF1 Swiftwater Squads to search for a boat seen drifting in the Brazos River. The boat was successfully located and proved to be a non-emergency.

On April 29, 2023, all teams from TX-TF1 and TX-TF2 were released after the severe weather exited the state and returned to their home stations.
