

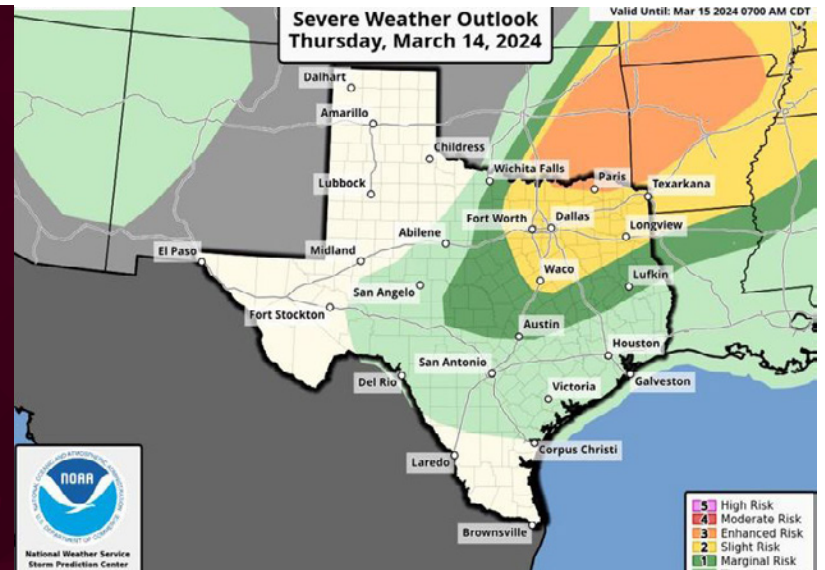
Deployment Statistics

- 2 TX-TF1 Swiftwater Rescue Squads

Type – **RAIN**



On March 14, 2024, the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 (TX-TF1) and Texas Task Force 2 (TX-TF2) in expectation of severe weather and flooding across Texas. The resources included a Type 4 Urban Search and Rescue Team from TX-TF2, and 2 Swiftwater Rescue Squads from TX-TF1. The teams staged overnight in Dallas and College Station, respectively. Over the next 2 days the Water Squads relocated strategically while monitoring weather patterns.

On March 16, 2024, with the weather threat passing TDEM released all TX-TF2 resources. The following day, March 17, 2024, one of the TX-TF1 Water Squads was also released leaving one more squad on standby in College Station.

On March 18, 2024, after no overnight requests for service, the final water squad was also released. All resources returned to their home stations for gear and equipment rehabilitation.
