Type - RAIN

On April 2, 2025, the State Operations Center (SOC) activated a Type 3 Water Capable US&R Team, three Type 3 Swiftwater Rescue Squads along with one Floodwater Rescue Squad, and a Water Group Supervisor (WGS) package from Texas A&M Task Force 1 (TX-TF1). The following day, April 3, 2025, all resources remained in their assigned locations monitoring the weather and maintaining contact with the local Agencies Having Jurisdiction (AHJ's).

On April 4, 2025, the SOC activated an additional Type 3 Water Capable US&R Team from Texas Task Force 2 (TX-TF2) to adapt to the changing weather conditions. TX-TF1 staged overnight in College Station and TX-TF2 staged overnight in Dallas. After some repositioning throughout the day, the water squads staged overnight in their final assigned locations.

On April 5, 2025, a few water squads were repositioned again throughout the day. All resources staged overnight awaiting requests for service.

On April 6, 2025, all resources were demobilized and returned home to rehabilitate their boats and equipment.
