

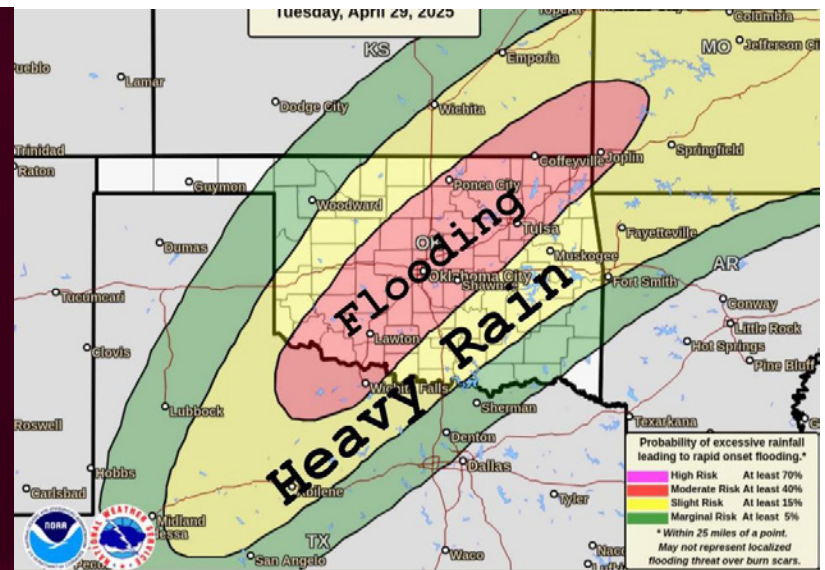
Deployment Statistics

Lasted a total of 18 days

188 Personnel activated supporting the following resources:

- 13 Swiftwater Rescue Squads
- 3 Water Group Supervisor Packages
- 2 Type 3 Water Capable US&R Teams
- 1 Canine Search Mission Ready Package

Type – **RAIN**



On April 23, 2025, the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) requested two Swiftwater Rescue Squads and a Water Group Supervisor (WGS) package from Texas A&M Task Force 1 (TX-TF1) in preparation for possible flash flooding in TDEM Regions 1 and 7. The following day, TDEM requested three more Type 3 Swiftwater Rescue Squads and another WGS package as the flash flood threat expanded into TDEM Regions 2 and 8.

On April 25th, two Water Squads were demobilized along with WGS-Deramus. On April 28th, TDEM requested a Type 3 Water Capable Search & Rescue Team from Texas Task Force 2 (TX-TF2) to prepare for more incoming severe weather.

On April 30th, TX-TF1 activated another Swiftwater squad at the request of TDEM. On May 2nd, two additional water squads were added at the request of TDEM. On May 3rd, three water squads were demobilized. On May 4th, the TX-TF2 Type 3 team was also demobilized.

On May 5th, at the request of the State Operations Center (SOC) TX-TF1 sent a Canine Search Mission Ready Package (MRP) to assist the City of Brenham with locating a young female swept away by the flood waters. Two water squads were activated as mutual aid to assist with search efforts. That afternoon, Keith Brown also deployed to Brenham to assist as Water Branch Director.

On May 6th, following the conclusion of the Brenham search, the squads repositioned around the state according to operational need. The following day, WS-Conroe completed a reconnaissance mission in Walker County at the request of the EMC. That evening, four water squads and WGS-Abney were demobilized. On May 8th, TX-TF1 activated a Type 3 Water Capable Urban Search & Rescue (US&R) Team along with a Floodwater rescue squad. Another water squad was also demobilized. On May 10th, all remaining resources were demobilized.
