Type - RAIN

On June 2, 2025, the State Operations Center (SOC) activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 (TX-TF1) in preparation for severe weather and flood risk in central Texas. They deployed two Type 3 Swiftwater Rescue Squads.

On June 5, 2025, Texas Task Force 2 (TX-TF2) activated a Type 3 Urban Search & Rescue (USAR) team, and TX-TF1 activated two additional Swiftwater Rescue Squads. That evening Water Group Supervisor (WGS) Package Kane and Schott assisted a family of 5 that attempted to drive their vehicle through the floodwaters.

On June 8, 2025, TX-TF1 activated a Type 3 USAR team to stage in College On June 10, 2025, three more Swiftwater Rescue Squads were activated along with an additional WGS package. The water squads were strategically split into East and West divisions to improve the WGS's span of control. On June 11, 2025, a Helicopter Search and Rescue Team (HSART) was activated. That morning, WS-Longview assisted a stranded motorist at a flooded underpass.

On June 12, 2025, the water squads responded to New Braunfles, with WS-WashCo/Conroe responding to an active rescue with 1 individual stranded in the water. Later, an additional Swiftwater team was activated along with a Canine Search Mission Ready Package (MRP) to assist with the search of multiple vehicles in the water and numerous missing persons. On June 13, 2025, the TX-TF2 team completed a wide area search mission in Streetman for a missing woman who's vehicle was swept away. She was found in her home after clinging to a tree and waiting for the waters to recede. Meanwhile, the TX-TF1 team assisted with search operations in San Antonio. On June 14, both the TX-TF1 and TX-TF2 teams completed their missions and returned to their staging areas.

On June 15, 2025, multiple resources were demobilized including 2 Swiftwater squads, the TX-TF1 team, and the TX-TF2 team. On
