On June 9, 2004, severe storms and flooding affected Parker County, prompting GDEM to activate TX-TF1. As a result, TX-TF1 mobilized and deployed a Water Rescue Strike Team, consisting of 4 Water Rescue Squads, as well as logistics and communications personnel to Parker County. GDEM also authorized the activation of a UH-60 Blackhawk helicopter and 1 TX-TF1 HSART to assist with search and rescue operations. The Texas Army National Guard helicopter crew and HSART staged at Bergstrom Airport in Austin ready to respond to any calls of assistance.

As flooding continued to worsen, TX-TF1 mobilized a second Water Rescue Strike Team, consisting of 4 Water Rescue Squads late that evening and staged the team in Weatherford, TX.

The TX-TF1 Water Rescue Strike Teams assisted local officials in Parker and Wise County and responded to a number of calls for assistance. All resources were demobilized on June 11 as flooding subsided.
