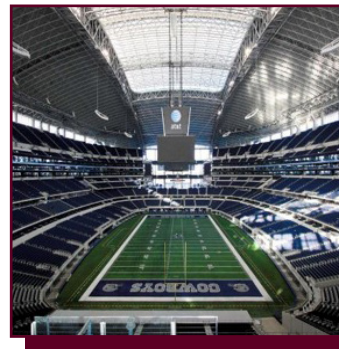
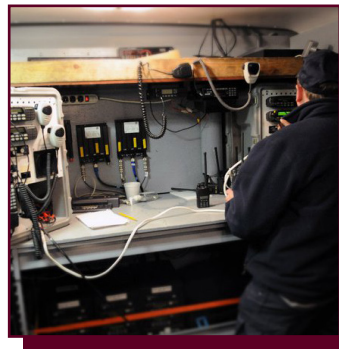
Type - **SECURITY SENSITIVE (NON-WATER)**



On February 4, 2011, in preparation for the 2011 Super Bowl (Pittsburgh Steelers vs Green Bay Packers) in Dallas, TX, TDEM activated a TX-TF1 SAR Overhead Team and the ESF-9 Coordination Center in College Station, Texas, to begin the mobilization of the task force for deployment.

On the morning of February 5, TX-TF1 activated a Type-I US&R Task Force to be staged outside of Dallas, 1 ESF-9 Coordinators, and 6 Liaison Officers to support operations. The ESF-9 Coordinator was assigned to the SOC, while the 6 ESF-9 coordinators were assigned to the Garland DDC. While on standby in Arlington, TX, the Type-I US&R Task Force worked in coordination with multiple other state and federal response teams in North Texas, including the newly created TXMF Joint Task Force 71.

All TX-TF1 resources remained deployed throughout Super Bowl XLV which occurred on February 6, and all were demobilized the following day on February 7, after no major incidents occurred.
