In anticipation of the landfall of Hurricane Florence on the Southeast Coast, FEMA activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 on Sept. 11, 2018. TX-TF1 deployed a 16-member FEMA Water Mission Ready Package to North Carolina, which was initially staged in Raleigh to deploy where needed to support local jurisdictions. In addition, 2 TX-TF1 members deployed to North Carolina as part of a FEMA US&R Incident Support Team (IST) and 8 were deployed to support the FEMA US&R IST Central Cache.

TX-TF1 members participated in water rescue and evacuation operations and welfare checks on those sheltering-in-place in both North Carolina and South Carolina. All teams were demobilized on Oct. 7, after completing the 150th deployment for the Task Force.
