24 Personnel activated supporting the following resources:

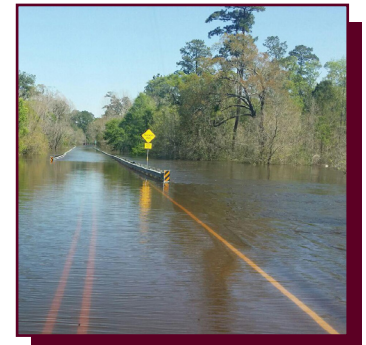
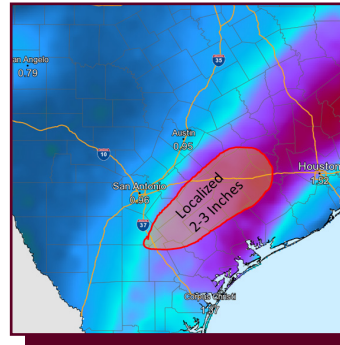
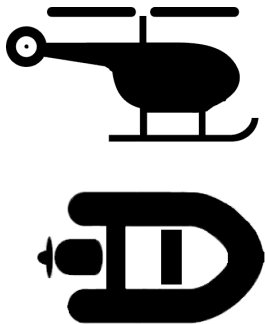
- 4 Water Rescue Squads

Beginning in March 2015, Texas began experiencing large amounts of rain causing localized flooding. As a result, TDEM activated TX-TF1 to assist with search and rescue operations throughout South and Central Texas. As part of the response, TX-TF1 deployed 4 Water Rescue Squads.

Water Rescue Squads remained deployed for 3 days assisting local jurisdictions with any requests for assistance. All squads demobilized on March 21, after flooding had subsided.
