- 11 Sheltered in Place

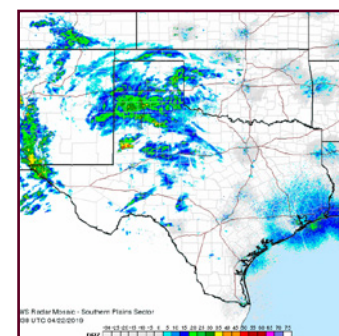
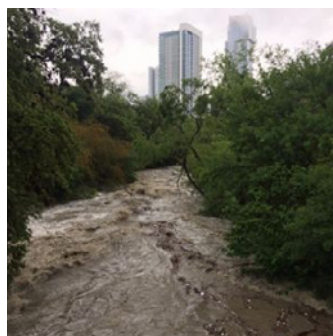

On April 23, the Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas Task Force 1 to prepare for possible flash flooding and severe weather across the state of Texas. A total of 14 personnel including Two Water Rescue Squads, one Water Group Supervisor, and one Support Specialist deployed to Regions 4, 5, and 6 to assist locals.

On the April 24, they assisted the Waco Fire Department and Texas Parks and Wildlife Department with evacuating an RV park. Water squad members from Dallas assisted in searching for a missing three-year-old that was swept out of a car early in the morning. The Dallas squad found the victim and initiated a route to Waco.

On April 25, all resources were demobilized as the storms were exiting Texas. Throughout the deployment the squads conducted multiple welfare checks and served as backup for first responders.
