In July of 2019 Hurricane Barry headed for Louisiana, bringing with it the possibility of heavy rain and flooding, hail, and tornadoes across the state. To be prepared, Louisiana State Fire Marshals Office requested a Type III US&R Water Capable Team and a Water Mission Ready Package from FEMA.

On Friday, July 12, TX-TF 1 deployed the Type III Team and the MRP-W to assist the Baton Rouge, Louisiana area with the possible severe weather. On July 13, the teams arrived to their Base of Operations at the PARDS Aquatic Center in Denham Springs, LA. Over the next two days the teams monitored the weather, performed a tactical review of Survey123 and their equipment, and sheltered in place during multiple tornado warnings.

With no requests for assistance or misions, TX-TF1 resources were demobilized on July 15.
