### Deployment Statistics

Lasted a total of 5 days

On April 28, 2021, the Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 in preparation for severe thunderstorms that were anticipated to bring hail, high winds and tornadoes, and flash flooding. They initially activated four Water Rescue Squads, one Water Group Supervisor, and a Support Specialist. These resources were staged along I-35 in cities including Fort Worth, Austin, and San Antonio. In the following days one rescue was performed in Bexar County.

On April 30, 2021, four additional Water Rescue Squads along with a Water Group Supervisor and Support Specialist were added to cover more area. Throughout May 1-2, five more rescues were performed with one in Bexar County, two in Gillespie County, and two in Llano County.

On May 2, 2021, with no further requests for service and the storms clearing, all resources were demobilized by TDEM.
