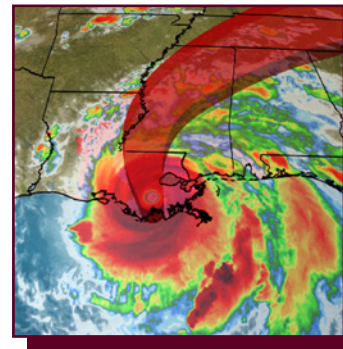

On August 27, 2021, the Federal Emergency Management Association activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 as a Type 1 Water Capable Team in preparation for Tropical Cyclone Ida heading for central Louisiana. The team staged in College Station until early on August 29, 2021, when they moved to Lafayette, LA.

Over the following days they relocated around Louisiana performing searches of the bayous and conducting damage assessments of structures. On September 3, 2021, the team demobilized back to College Station. This response included 16 assists, 16 evacuations, hundreds sheltered-in-place, multiple welfare checks, and hundreds of damaged or destroyed structures identified.
