On January 24, 2023, severe weather moved into Texas bringing with it the threat of tornadoes South of Houston between Beaumont and Victoria. The Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas Task Force 1 as a Type 3 Search and Rescue Team to assist affected areas. In the afternoon an EF-3 tornado touched down in Houston and traveled through Deer Park and Pasadena. Due to major damage, the team was deployed to these areas. The team then staged overnight at the Pasadena Convention Center.

On January 25, 2023, the teams spent the day surveying damage in the affected areas and assisting the local authorities with various tasks including locating classified documents lost in the debris. They remained overnight in Pasadena again and on January 26, 2023, assisted the locals with numerous well checks and conducted infrastructure damage observations.

After no overnight requests for service, the team was released early in the morning on January 27, 2023 to demobilize back to their home stations.
