- 1 Pet Evacuation

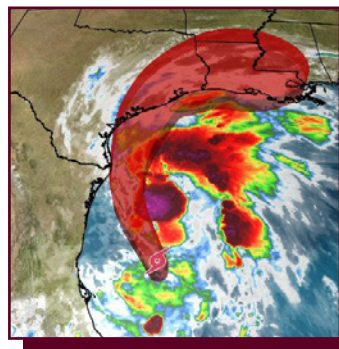

On September 12, 2021, the Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 in preparation for Tropical Storm Nicholas making landfall along the Texas coast. The team consisted of 7 Swiftwater Rescue Squads, 1 Floodwater Rescue Squad, 2 Water Group Supervisors, and Support Specialists to stage along the Texas coast covering regions 2 and 3.

On September 13, 2021, TDEM activated additional resources including 6 Helicopter Search and Rescue Technicians, 1 Helicopter Search and Rescue Manager, 1 more Swiftwater Rescue Squad, and 3 Liaison Officers to be based at various locations. The following day on September 14, 2021, in the height of the storm, 5 rescues and a pet evacuation were completed. TDEM also activated 3 more Helicopter Search and Rescue Technicians.

On September 15, 2021, 3 Water Rescue Squads and all Helicopter Search and Rescue Technicians were released with most of the severe weather leaving the state. The remaining resources were demobilized the following day on September 16, 2021 after no further requests for service.
