## TROPICAL STORM BETA

### Deployment Statistics

Lasted a total of 4 days

129 Personnel activated supporting the following resources:

- Type 3 Search and Rescue Team
- 11 Water Rescue Boat Squads

Type – **RAIN**



On September 19, 2020, Tropical Storm Beta made landfall along the Southern end of the Matagorda Peninsula on the Texas coast. Heavy rain fell around Matagorda Bay and the Victoria Crossroads, measuring up to 10". On September 20, 2020, in preparation for possible flooding, Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 as a Type 3 Search and Rescue Team along with 11 Water Rescue Boat Squads.

The teams were stationed in Texas Regions 2 and 6 to assist the local jurisdictions if needed. On September 23, 2020, after no requests for service, the teams demobilized to return to College Station.
