On March 1, 2023, the Texas State Operations Center released a briefing detailing severe weather entering the Eastern side of the state. The storm brought the possibility of heavy rain, high winds, tornadoes, and large hail. In preparation for this weather event, the Texas Division of Emergency Management activated Texas A&M Task Force 1 & 2 as Type 3 Search and Rescue teams.

On March 2, 2023, the teams were activated at their home stations Gateway and Hensley Field. They remained ready overnight awaiting assignments.

Overnight the storm left the state and there were no requests for service. On March 3, 2023, all resources from both teams were demobilized and returned to their home stations.
