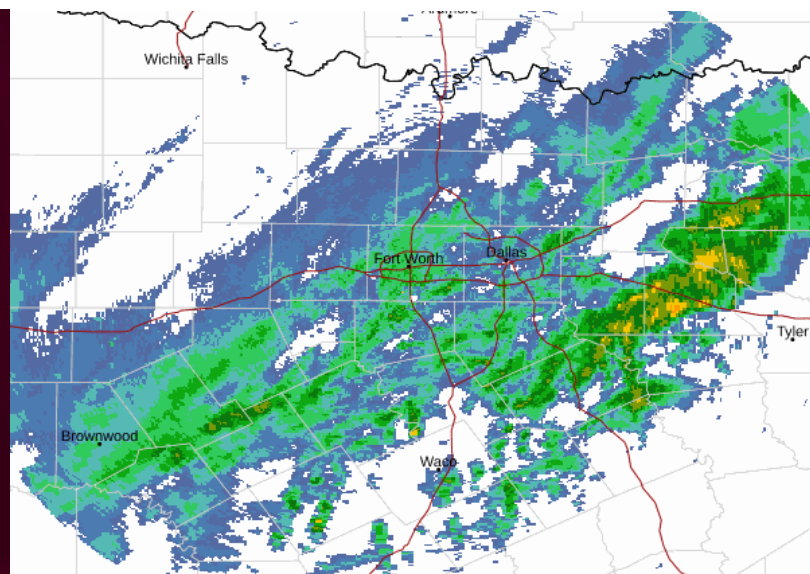
Deployment Statistics

On January 31, 2023, severe winter storms moved across the state with ice storm warnings across portions of Western and Central Texas. With freezing rain expected in many areas over the next 36 hours, Texas Division of Emergency Management requested 2 Swiftwater Rescue Squads to prepare for possible flash flooding. The teams remained stationed at Gateway awaiting orders.

On February 1, 2023, after consulting the State Operations Center, the teams were pushed closer to the areas of greatest threat and stationed in Liberty and Nacogdoches.

On February 3, 2023, after no further requests for service, all resources were demobilized back to their home stations.
